Also while at University, he designed and tested improved carbon fiber outriggers for rowing boats. As part of this project, Mr. Winter developed an improved adjustment system for rowing boats and ultimately received a patent to this invention.

While in law school, Mr. Winter was a multiple time United States National Rowing Team member, competing at a number of World Cup and World Championship events and he also won the Lake Placid Ironman in 2012.

Mr. Winter is also an FAA licensed private pilot with an instrument rating. This allows him to easily visit clients and travel to court appearances and depositions outside Connecticut.
